

After Surgery

Recovery Room:

Generally, all patients go to the recovery room for a minimum of one hour. Nurses will be checking your blood pressure frequently. This is routine, and should not be cause for concern. After you have awakened (and your condition indicates) you will be transferred back to your room.

Day of Surgery:

It is not unusual to be very sleepy and drift in and out of sleep for several hours after a general anesthetic. Because of this, many patients do not have a clear memory of this period immediately following surgery. However, during this time the nurses will be checking you frequently, applying ice to the scrotum, and checking the placement of the pump in the scrotal sac.

If you experience any discomfort, there will be medication ordered to relieve it.

Some bed rest for two days after surgery helps to prevent swelling, bruising and discomfort.
